The Maluti-A-Phofung Special Economic Zone (MAP-SEZ) is a subsidiary of the Free State Development Corporation (FDC) which is a public entity established in terms of the Free State Development Act 6 of 1995 (FDC Act), as amended. In terms of the Public Finance Management Act it is classified as a schedule 3D provincial public entity.

Maluti-A-Phofung Special Economic Zone invites suitably qualified Contractors / Joint Ventures or Consortiums, to submit bid offers for the provision of bulk earthworks development at the Industriqwa Industrial Estate in Harrismith.

Mandatory Requirements

- Valid Tax Clearance certificate and a unique Security Personal Identification Pin issued by the South African Revenue Service
- CIDB grading of 9CE (8CE PE acceptable)

Applicable Criteria

Bids will be evaluated on functionality (detailed functionality criteria is outlined in the bid document). Bidders failing to obtain a minimum of 80 out of 100 points for functionality will not be eligible to be evaluated on price and preference points.

The bid will be evaluated on Stage 2: Financial Offer and Preference (90/10) where 90 points will be allocated for price and 10 points for preference points.
